Summit UU Fellowship Covenant of Care

In practicing our Unitarian Universalist Principles and Purposes and with Love as our guide, we covenant to support the care and well-being of all during our in-person gatherings using the following points of care. We recognize that there are members of our community who cannot be vaccinated. We also recognize that the Delta variant is *highly contagious* and airborne.

Therefore we care for the most vulnerable in our Fellowship by:

- For all Summit gatherings, indoor or outside and regardless of size, masks are required.
- Staying home rather than attending in-person gatherings if we are ill or we are feeling like we are becoming sick, have a fever or have been exposed to someone who is ill. (This includes colds, flu, etc.)
- Agreeing to notify the Summit Office and the Fellowship Community if we have been exposed to COVID-19 and have been physically in contact with members of the community on campus or at a Summit function.

This is a living document and will be adapted as our community care needs evolve, and as virus levels in the county decline.

As of 8/11/21, we are operating at a 50% pre-COVID occupancy.
